Privacy Policy

We hope you will enjoy using the Jack Coupe & Sons Ltd website ("website"), and we want to make sure your experience is as safe and useful as possible. What is Personal Data?

Personal data is defined in the UK GDPR 'any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (data subject')'.

Personal data is, in simpler terms, any information that relates to you as a living individual. Personal data covers obvious information such as your name and contact details, but it also covers less obvious information such as identification numbers, electronic location data, online identifiers and other information relating to you.

Personal information that we collect, why we collect it and how we use it.

We obtain information about you when you use our website and we also receive information from you, for example when you are viewing our services or making online enquiries. We need this information to enable us to provide our online services and where appropriate, our offline services. This section sets out in more detail what information we collect, why we collect it, how we use it and how long we keep your information.

- Phone calls may be recorded, and any recorded calls will be retained for a maximum of 12 months and only be used for training and quality purposes.
- We have CCTV at our premises which we use to prevent or detect crime.

Apart from consent, the lawful basis for our use of your personal information is 'legitimate interests'. That is that we're collecting or using your information because it benefits you, our organisation or someone else, without causing an undue risk of harm to anyone. All of your data protection rights may apply, except the right to portability. Our legitimate interests are:

- To have you as a contact point for our customer or supplier to whom we provide or from whom we receive goods or services, including in their account, any permitted marketing and to deal with any issues.
- To protect our business including our premises.

What are my rights?

Under the UK GDPR, you have the following rights:

- a) The right to be informed about our collection and use of your personal data. This Privacy Notice should tell you everything you need to know, but you can always contact our Data Protection Manager via 01388 774040 or moya@jackcoupeandsonsltd.co.uk.
- b) The right to access the personal data we hold about you.
- c) The right to have your personal data rectified if any of your personal data held by us is inaccurate or incomplete.
- d) The right to be forgotten, i.e. the right to ask us to delete or otherwise dispose of any of your personal data that we have.
- e) The right to restrict (i.e. limit) our processing of your personal data.
- f) The right to object to us using your personal data for a particular purpose or purposes.
- g) The right to data portability. This means that, if you have provided personal data to us directly, we are using it with your consent or for the performance of a contract, you can ask us for a copy of that personal data to re-use with another service or business in many cases.
- h) Rights relating to automated decision-making and profiling. We do not currently use your personal data in this way.
- i) The right to withdraw consent at any time.

If you are concerned that we are not using your information in accordance with the law, or are not satisfied with our response to a request made above, then you can complain to the Information Commissioner's Office.

How do you use my personal data?

Under the UK GDPR, we must always have a lawful basis for using personal data. This may be because the data is necessary for our performance of a contract with you, because you have consented to our use of your personal data, or because it is in our legitimate business interests to use it. Your personal data may be used for one or more of the following purposes:

- Supplying our services to your employer (our customer or supplier). Your personal details are required for us to enter into a contract with your employer.
- Providing and managing your employer's account.
- Personalising and tailoring our services for you.
- Communicating with you. This may include responding to emails or calls from you and providing you with the information you requested.

This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction and providing information to law enforcement bodies.
- To professional advisers, so they can provide us with advice.
- In connection with a sale or potential sale of our company or all or part of our business.

How we use cookies
